

Report on the Two-Day National Seminar - “Different Commentaries on Bhagavad-Gita”

The Department of Vedanta, Government Sanskrit College, Tripunithura, organized a Two-Day National Seminar as part of the Śaṅkarajayanti Celebration on 5th and 6th May 2022. The theme of the seminar was “Different Commentaries on Bhagavad-Gita.”
