The Kavyaprakasha is a Sanskrit book written by Mammataharya in the 11th century. The merit of the work is that it is divided into 10 ullasa comprised as Vritti, Karika and examples which elaborate the whole components of poetry. Among the numerous treatises on Sanskrit rhetoric no work is more celebrated than the Kavyaprakasha. Accordingly, no less than forty-seven scholars are said to have written commentaries on the famous work. These commentaries are best instances of the reputation and acceptance of the work. The great merit of the work is divided into 10 ullasa comprises as usual Vritti, Karika and Examples. Mammata deals all topics of poetics except dramaturgy. He refers to great poets like Kalidasa, Sisharsha and others to define the whole portions of Kavya. Actually, the work of Mammata is based upon the works of his predecessors. Even after 11 centuries, the treatise is being studied as a basic text in poetics shows the greatness of the work.
